6th Inter-College and Inter-University Debate Competition
During the Academic Year 2010-2011

Dear

1. It is a matter of great satisfaction for us that students from your University have been participating in the Debate - Event organized by the IAPPD since 2005. Debate - Competition on the broad theme of Population, Development and Environment is the annual feature with IAPPD. It is our firm belief that for achieving meaningful results regarding population issues facing our country in general and society in particular, the participation of youth will be the most effective. The objective of the debate at University and national level is to strengthen youth skill and capacity to enhance their awareness on importance of youth participation in population, development and environment concerns, strategies and programmes.

The debate competition will be in either in English or in Hindi Languages. Universities conducting the Inter-College Competition would be eligible to field one team of two students (one favouring and one against the motion) in the Inter-University Debate Competition at the National Level, which will become an annual feature.

3. The National Level Debate Competition will be held on 19 - 20 November, 2010 at Delhi. A circular indicating exact dates, timings, venue, topics and other details will be issued separately.

4. For the Inter-College Debate Competition (Organized at the University Level) we will provide funds for three prizes amounting to Rs.3000/-, R.2000/- and Rs.1500/- to be awarded to first, second and third best debater respectively. In addition a consolation prize of Rs.1000/- may also be awarded if the number of participants exceeds 20. We will also award Merit Certificates and certificates of participation to the winners and participating students in these Inter-College Competitions. To sumup, IAPPD will pay a sum of Rs.7,500/- (Rs. Seven thousand five hundred only) to the universities to conduct Inter-University College debate competition. No extra money will be paid to the universities for the students who are attending the university level debate - towards travelling allowance and daily allowance. No honorarium to the judges also. The amount paid on Tea and snacks will also not re-imbursable. All these expenses are to be met by the universities themselves.

5. At the National Level Debate, we will award two sets of prizes. The first set of prize money will be given to the winning team universities at the above National level debate. The prize amount are as follows:-



1. The University, at the request of the Indian Association of Parliamentarians on Population and Development (IAPPD), New Delhi has decided to conduct Inter-College Debating Competition on Population and Environment. The venue, date, time and the subject of the competition are given hereunder:-

2. The competition is open to the colleges running degree courses and teaching departments/faculties of the University. Each college/teaching department/faculty can depute only one team of 2 debaters to this competition – one speaking for and one against the proposition.

3. Ordinarily three prizes of the value of Rs.3000/-, Rs.2000/- and Rs.1500/- will be awarded to the first, second and third prize winners in the Debate. In addition a consolation prize of Rs.1000/- will also be awarded if the number of participants exceeds 20. Prize-winners will also get Merit Certificates and all participants will get Participation Certificates.

4. The winners in the Inter-College Competition will be eligible to participate in the National Level Competition, which will be conducted by the Indian Association of Parliamentarians on Population and Development (IAPPD) at Delhi on **19-20 November 2010**.
