Subject:- Inter - Collegiate Debating Competitions on Cooperation
to be organized by Universities during the Academic Year
2010-2011- Regarding.

Dear Sir,

As you are kindly aware, that the National Council for Cooperative Training is an Apex Body entrusted with the task of formulating policies as well as organizing and directing arrangements of Cooperative Training in the country. The Council operates through its 14 Institutes of Cooperative Management, 5 Regional Institutes of Cooperative Management spread all over the country and one Vaikunth Mehta National Institute of Cooperative Management at Pune.

In order to infuse Cooperative spirit among the youth and stimulate their interest in cooperative ideology, the Council arranges to conduct Essay and Debating Competitions on Cooperation annually. Essay Competitions are presently conducted at University level only. Circular to this effect is being issued separately. Inter Collegiate Debating Competitions are organized first at University level followed by an Inter University Debating Competition at National Level.

Debating Competitions are held in English and Hindi languages separately. Universities conducting Inter Collegiate Debating Competitions are eligible to select one team (2 persons; one favoring the motion and one against the motion) each for Hindi and English competition at National Level. University students generally take these competitions as an opportunity to interact with academicians and leaders dedicated to the cause of cooperative ideology.

This year also, the National Debating Competition will be held in the month of December, 2010 for which a circular indicating dates, time, venue, topics and other details will be issued separately in due course of time.

3. Individual prizes of Rs.4000/-, Rs.3000/- and Rs.2000/- are awarded to the debators adjudged first, second, third respectively, separately for Hindi and English debates. Three consolation prizes of Rs.1000/- each, on Hindi and English debates besides several prizes sponsored by National/State level Cooperative Organizations are also awarded. In addition, winning team is awarded a Scroll and the Trophy. The runners-up team is awarded Runners Cup. Merit Certificates and Certificates of participation are awarded to individual winners and participants respectively. Besides, the Council also meets TA/DA expenses of the participants in these Debating Competitions as per rules enclosed as per **Annexure-I**.

4. For Inter-Collegiate Debating Competitions (organized at University level), three prizes amounting to Rs.1000/-, Rs.800/- and Rs.600/- are awarded to the first, second and third best debaters and two additional consolation prizes of Rs.300/- each, if the number of participating teams exceeds 20. Merit Certificates and Certificates of participation are also awarded to the winners and participating students in these Inter-Collegiate Debating Competitions. The Council in this case, however, only reimburses expenditure on TA to the outstation students, as

stipulated in the scheme. We are enclosing the detailed scheme of these Inter-Collegiate and National Level Debating Competitions.

5. As the National Debating Competitions on Cooperation are scheduled in December, 2010 we request you that competitions at University level may be completed and names of First and Second winners be intimated to us by **31st October, 2010**. For convenience, a specimen notification to be issued by the university for holding the Inter-Collegiate competitions is given at **Annexure-II**.


6. We are further enclosing herewith the Scheme Proforma **D-I (Annexure-III)** for **submission of report and claims and Proforma D-II (Annexure -IV)** for **submission of TA claims**. These claims may please be submitted to this office immediately after the conclusion of debate at University level **latest by 31st December, 2010**. It may kindly be noted that the prizes are to be awarded depending upon participation of number of teams, as indicated in the scheme, and also there is no provision in the rules towards payment of TA/DA, honorarium/incidental charges to the Judges or any expenditure on entertainment as we expect that the University would bear this expenditure out of their own normal funds.

7. We shall appreciate if you kindly confirm your acceptance to conduct these competitions by **10th October, 2010**. We would also request you to please let us know the name and designation of the person in the University with whom we should make correspondence in this respect.

ANNEXURE -I

Rule for Organizing Inter-Collegiate and National Debating Competition on Cooperation Sponsored by National Council for Cooperative Training.

1. DEFINITION

- 1.1 For the purpose of these rules, "University" shall include the recognized University in India, Institution having the status of a University and the National Council for Rural Higher Education.
- 1.2 "College" shall include Educational Institutions running Degree Courses affiliated to the Universities and Teaching Departments of the Universities.
- 1.3 "Council" means the National Council for Cooperative Training, New Delhi.

2. INTER-COLLEGIATE DEBATE

Date & Participation

- 2.1 Each University may organize an Inter-collegiate Debating Competition on a subject relating to Cooperation. The Competition may be held latest by the end of **September,2010** unless otherwise permitted by the Council. The University shall notify the date of the competition to its affiliated/constituent Colleges Teaching Department etc. well in advance. A copy of such notification may be forwarded to this Council.
- 2.2 Every affiliated/constituent College, Faculty/Teaching Deptt. Of the University shall be entitled to send only one team of 2 debators to this competition one of them speaking for and the other speaking against the proposition. The colleges/teaching departments will be entitled to send only one team, irrespective whether the Debate is held in Hindi or in English or in both languages. The University will hold only one Debate at the Inter-College level.

Subject

- 2.3 The subject for the debate, a topic relating to cooperation, will be prescribed by the University who may also suggest suitable reference material on the subject for the benefit of the participants. The Council shall be glad to render any advice in this behalf, if called upon to do so. The University in this regard can also take held of the local Cooperative Institutions, Training Set up.

Panel of Judges

2.4 A panel of three judges shall be constituted by the University for evaluating the performance of competitors. The panel may preferably include:

- (i) Head of Faculty of Commerce/Economics/Cooperation
- (ii) A prominent non-official Cooperator and head of Institute/Faculty Member of nearby ICM of NCCT
- (iii) A Senior Cooperative Officer

Prizes

2.5 The Council shall award a University Scroll to the College, Department of the University whose team is adjudged the best in the Inter-Collegiate Debate. Team for this purpose shall be a team of two debators one speaking for and the other speaking against the proposition as defined in Rule 2.2.

2.6 The Council may also award 3 prizes of the value of Rs. 1000/- Rs. 800/- and Rs. 600/- and 2 consolation prizes of the value of Rs. 300/- each in order of merit, on the recommendation of the panel of judges.

2.7 The Prizes shall be awarded on the basis of entries for the competition in the following manner :

Number of Teams	Number of Prizes
(i) Upto 5 Teams	One Prize
(ii) 6 to 10 Teams	Two Prizes
(iii) More than 10 Teams	Three Prizes
(iv) More than 20 Teams	Three Prizes + 2 Consolation Prizes of Rs. 300/- each

2.8 Part of the prizes may be paid in cash and balance in the shape of book on cooperation to be supplied by Council.

Traveling Allowances

- 2.9 The competitors in case of non-residential University coming from the Colleges outside the University Headquarters may be paid to and fro 2nd class Railway fare/ordinary bus fare. No other allowance i.e. incidentals or daily allowance or local bus charges shall, however, be admissible.

Reports and Claims

- 2.10 Expenditure incurred on prizes and travel cost as admissible under the scheme, shall be reimbursed by the Council on presentation of the report and claims in this behalf(Annexure-III). University shall present the report/claim of the competition in Annexure-III Form D(1), in duplicate, to the Council. The claim shall be pre-receipted on a revenue stamps for the full amount of prizes by the Council and T.A. The details of T.A. Claims of the participants may be furnished in Form D(2), duly certified as correct.

Certificate

- 2.11 The winner in the Inter-Collegiate Debate shall be awarded Certificate of merit by Council. The other participants in the Debate may be given participation certificates.
- 2.12 Duplicate copy of the certificates of Inter-Collegiate Debating Competition on Cooperation will be issued to the participants on request through proper channel.

3. NATIONAL DEBATE

Date, Venue and Subject

- 3.1 The Council may organize Inter-University National Debating Competitions on Cooperation separately in Hindi and English, in collaboration with University and/or Cooperative Institutions. The National Debaters may be held some time in December every year. The date, exact venue and the subject of the National Debates will be notified later.

Eligibility

- 3.2 The University holding Inter-Collegiate Debating Competition shall be eligible to participate in the National Debates. As separate National Debates are to be held i.e., in English and Hindi, the University, while holding the Inter-Collegiate Debate will select two teams one for Hindi and the other for English language National Debate.
- 3.3 Each Team will comprise of two debaters one speaking for and the other speaking against the proposition to be indicated by the Council. The teams chosen for the National Debates shall be best teams of the University Debate. The participating teams will bring with them a letter of introduction from their respective Universities. The debator will, however, be eligible to participate only in one of the National Debates either in Hindi or English language National Debate.

Panel of Judges

- 3.4 A panel of judges for assessing the performance of the Debaters may be constituted by the Council in consultation with the University where the National Debating Competition will be held.

Prizes

- 3.5 The Council shall award a National Scroll and a Running Shield to the University, whose team is adjudged the best. The Runners-up will get the Runners Cup.
- 3.6 First, Second and Third Prizes of the value of Rs. 4000/-, Rs.3000/- Rs. 2000/- respectively will be awarded on individual merit, Consolation prizes up to three of the value of Rs. 1000/- each, may also be awarded in the competition on the recommendations of panel of judges. Some more prizes may also be instituted by the Cooperative Institutions in the States, where the National Debates are held.

Traveling Allowances

- 3.7 The participants may be allowed 2nd class Railway fare from the respective University Town/Home Place to the place of competition and back. In case of places not connected by rail, ordinary bus fare may be granted.

- 3.8 Participants in the National Debate will be entitled to draw D.A. @ Rs. 100/- per day per head for the days spent in journey which may be restricted for 4 days maximum and Rs. 200/- maximum as conveyance charges for to and fro journey.
- 3.9 The students are expected to avail of student concession for the journeys performed by them for the National Debates. Full non-concessional fare will be allowed only in exceptional case, where for some reasons the students are not able to obtain the concession, on production of a certificate from the Principal/head of the Department that the concession was not available and also on submission of money receipt from the railway. The students will also be entitled to sleeper/reservation charges on production of Ticket. No TA/DA will however, be admissible to escorts accompanying them.

Certificate

- 3.10 While the winner shall be awarded the certificates of merit, certificates of participation shall be issued to other participants in the National Debates.
- 3.11 Duplicate copy of the certificate of National Competition will be issued to the participants on request through proper channel.

4. Relaxation and Interpretation

- 4.1 Any relaxation in these rules can be introduced only with the prior approval of the Secretary of the National Council for Cooperative Training.
- 4.2 In the event of any controversy arising out of the interpretation of the rules of clarification needed in the absence of any specific provision to that affect the interpretation given by the Secretary of the Council shall be final and binding on all concerned.

Subject :

2. The Competition is open to the colleges, running degree course and teaching departments/faculties of the University. Each college/teaching department/faculty can depute only one team of 2 debaters to this competition-one speaking for and the other speaking against the proposition.
3. According to the scheme, ordinarily three prizes of the value of Rs. 1000/- Rs,800/- and Rs. 600/- will be awarded to the first, second and third prize winners in the Debate. In addition, two consolation prizes of Rs. 300/- each may be awarded, if the number of teams participating in the Debates is more than 20. The number of prizes would depend on number of teams in Debates. The best team in the Debate will get University Scroll and the participants/winners participation/merit certificates to be awarded by the Council.
4. The winners in the Inter-Collegiate Debate will be eligible to participate in the National Debate which will be conducted separately in Hindi and English languages by the NCCT. For this purpose, based on the Inter-Collegiate debate, the university will select two teams one for English and the other for Hindi language National Debate. The Council normally awards three prizes of the value of Rs. 4000/-, Rs. 3000/- and Rs. 2000/- and in addition may also award several special and consolation prizes depending upon sponsorship for each of the National Debates to be held in Hindi and English language. Resume of the speech of first and second prize winners may be sent to the NCCT for publication in the NCCT Magazine along with their claims facilitating to admit their claims for payment.

5. Team from out-station colleges will be entitled to draw to and fro 2nd class railway fare/ordinary bus fare.
6. It is requested that your college/department may please arrange a debate on the above topics at an early date and communicate the name of two best debaters, to speak for and against the motion, to the undersigned, latest by _____ The information may please be supplied in the following Performa:
