In the current climate of cost cutting and downsizing, training professionals are under increasing pressure to provide positive, measurable evidence of the bottom line contribution of training program. Yet evaluating the effects and results of training program is notoriously difficult. Evaluation is concerned with collecting and presenting appropriate information in order to prove the relationship between training program and benefits to the education. Students and teachers can not benefit from evaluation that focuses on relatively unimportant aspects of material presented or demonstrated by students. With advent of standards based education, performance evaluation has become more widespread that is focussed on authentic or real world demonstrations of competencies as opposed to traditional paper pencil test.

Evaluation is the process by which training professionals can collect, analyse and present the information needed in order to prove the evaluation value of any training programme which has been delivered.

A common mistake which many educational institutions make is that they leave evaluation considerations until after they have planned and delivered their training program. For evaluation to be truly effective the evaluation strategy needs to be planned and designed in conjunction with, rather than after the training planning and design stages.

The knowledge and skills regarding evaluation strategies is must for good educational outcomes. Hereby, University College of Nursing, Faridkot is going to organise a four days workshop on “Strategies for Effective Evaluation in Health Sciences”

In the 13th century, the famous Sufi Saint Hazrat Baba Sheikh Farid on his way to Pakpattan (now in Pakistan) from Delhi happened to pass through this Princely State. The Baba pardoned the Raja and meditated at a place near the Fort, now known as 'Tilla Baba Farid' where he penanced for 40 days before proceeding to Pakpattan (now in Pakistan). From that day the name of Mokalhar was changed to Faridkot.

The city, Faridkot is one of the districts of Punjab, located in Malwa region. The sites worth seeing are, Tiilla Baba Farid ji ,Gurudwara Godri Sahib, Traditional fort, Indo Pakistan Border - Hussainiwala (35 kms from Faridkot).

AIM OF THE WORKSHOP

8. To update knowledge, attitude and practice of participants about trends and advances in evaluation strategies.

CONTENT:

This workshop will focus on educational objectives, overview of evaluation strategies, concept of evaluation, philosophy of evaluation, measurements, criteria for selection of evaluation strategies, strategies to assess knowledge, attitude & practice of students and development of model question papers for UG & PG students, designing MCQs and item analysis, reforms in evaluation system (OSCE & OSPE) and systematic steps in organising OSCE & OSPE.

The workshop will be conducted in the Multipurpose hall at University College of Nursing, Faridkot. The tutelage will be mixed of lectures as well as group discussions and Practical exercises.
