Ph.D. Course work (Course work - I)

Curriculum of coursework:

> As per Curriculum four courses will be conducted.

- Three courses [two courses (including Research Methodology-I (Biostatistics) and Research Methodology-II (Clinical Research demonstration); one course from core specialization (Major)] are compulsory to all candidates. The fourth course will be elective (Minor from core specialization). Every student will have to take one elective course out of a list of elective courses being offered by the University Centre of Excellence in Research.
- ➤ The elective course will normally be offered to students by the University Centre of Excellence in Research depending on the areas of interest of the candidates.
- > The minimum number of lectures will be 50 per paper.

Conductance of classes:

- > Theory lectures including research methodology as well as statistics will be conducted in UCER.
- Core specialized subjects will be taught by faculty of the concerned department at UCER iself.
- > Each lecture will be of one hour duration. Each course will carry 4 credits.

Continuous Assessment and Final University Examination:

- ➤ In each course 50% weightage will be given to continuous assessment or sessional work which will consist of two house tests/assignments (50%). Out of two house tests, one best will be considered.
- > A 50% weightage in each course will be given to final examination conducted by University Centre of Excellence in Research.
